3. Selection Criteria

- Successful applicants must meet both of the following;

1) Language proficiency requirements

- ① Applicants who acquired TOPIK (Test of Proficiency in Korean) level 3 or higher
N.B Applicants who are applying for Sports & IT must have TOPIK Level 2 or higher
- ② Applicants who have acquired TOEFL iBT 53 or IELTS 5.5 or TEPS 600 or higher
- ③ N.B No language requirements imposed to the applicants whose native language or second language is English.

2) Interview score is 60 points out of 100 or higher

- Unsuccessful applicants are;

- ① those whose interview score is less than 60;
- ② those who do not meet the admission requirements.

4. Application fee (KRW 60,000 KRW) should be remitted to BUFS bank account within the first week of March.
